

Cancellation Rules & Refund Policy and Procedure – July 2022 Drive (Bachelor Program):

1. The Admission Processing Fee / Registration fee of Rs. 1200/- is non-refundable.
2. Candidate who made payment of Registration fee and Initial amount of Rs.5000/- and opt for Registration cancellation, deduction applicable will be:
 - a. If documents are approved - No amount will be deducted and complete 5000/- will be refunded.
 - b. If Documents are either partially submitted or not submitted/re-submitted – 800/- will be deducted from 5000/- and balance will be refunded.
3. Candidates who made payment over and above 6200/- and opts for Registration Cancellation, deduction applicable will be:
 - a. Complete payment / Down payment – Rs. 1000/-
 - b. Instalment payment – Rs. 2500/-
4. Admission Cancellation request can be processed only when student is admitted to the University (student number is generated) and the request is received within the stipulated dates as announced by the University on the website for every admission cycle from time to time, whether the Student has paid Semester fee, Annual fee or Full fees.
5. Find below the Admission Cancellation dates and Deductions applicable as defined by the University for July 2022 batch:

3.8.2022	17.8.2022	Rs. 5000 + 20% of Semester fee
18.8.2022	17.9.2022	Rs. 5000 + 50% of Semester fee
After 17.9.2022	-	If Semester or Annual fee is paid Full Fees
	On or before June 2023	If Full program fee is paid – Rs. 5000 + Annual Fee

6. Calculation of charges are at sole discretion of the University.
7. The amount will be refunded back either via cheque/DD or will be transferred to the same account from which the payment was made, as mentioned by the candidate/student in the Admission/Registration Cancellation Form submitted.
8. Admission Cancellation is a facility provided only to Semester I students and Lateral admission (New admission) students and not applicable to the students re-registering for their successive Semester II, III and IV.
9. All terms and conditions mentioned in the Cancellation Policy in the Student Resource Handbook available on Student Portal are applicable.
